CURATOR'S NOTE

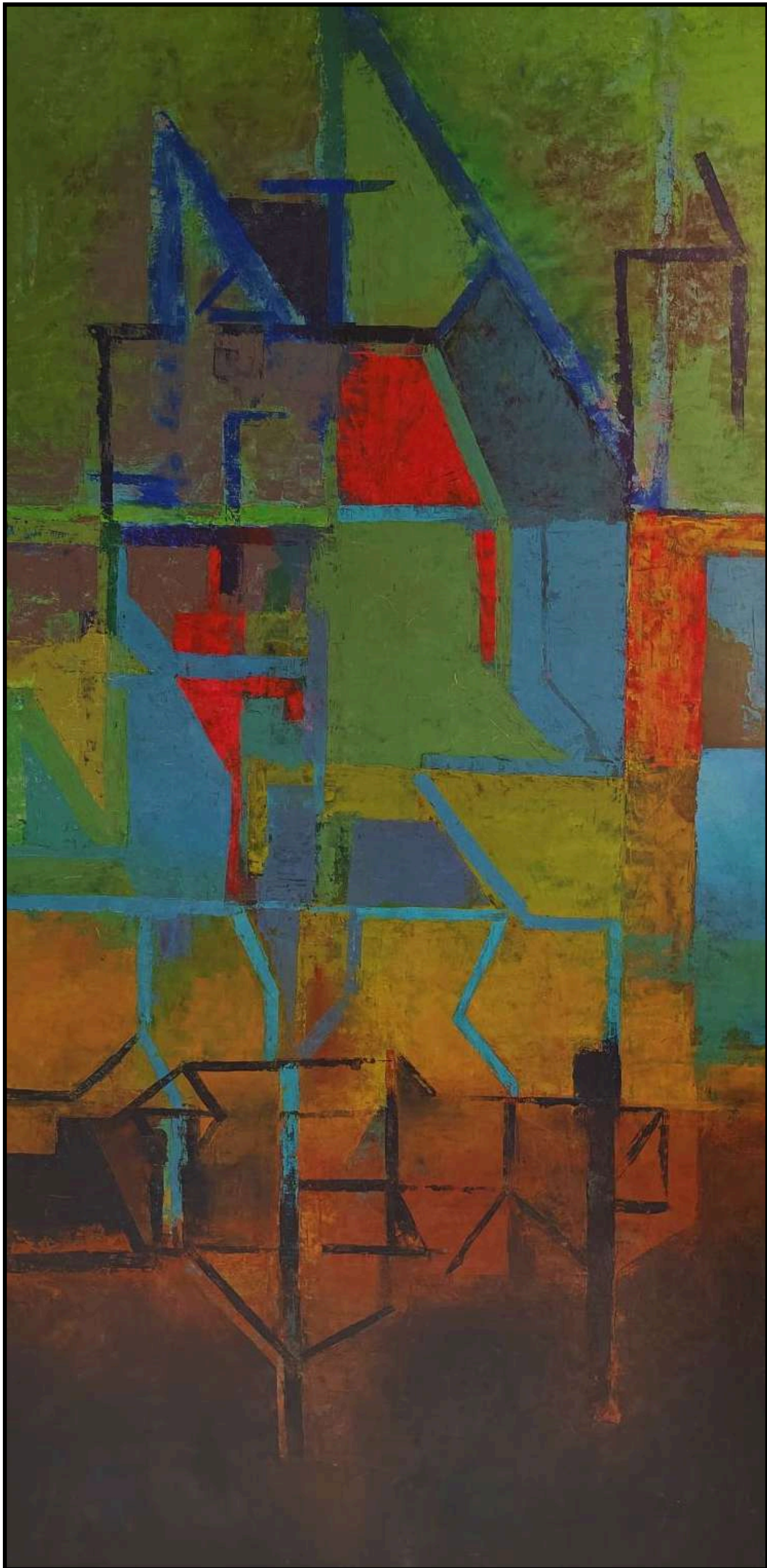
Spatial Dialogues brings together the works of Bhagwan Chavan, Dilipkumar Kesavan, Jacob Jebaraj and Pravin Kannanur in an exploration of space, materiality, memory and perception. While each artist approaches these ideas through a distinct visual language, this exhibition creates a shared dialogue between their practices and surroundings.

Bhagwan Chavan's layered compositions evoke urban memory and abstraction, while Dilipkumar Kesavan's works unfold through structural and emotional resonance. Jacob Jebaraj explores symbolic narratives that move between personal and collective memory and Pravin Kannanur investigates rhythm and transformation through form and spatial relationships.

Rather than existing as isolated expressions, these works interact through proximity, placement and spatial rhythm. This exhibition considers space not merely as a physical setting, but as an active and evolving presence shaped by artistic intervention and viewer engagement.

Spatial Dialogues invites viewers to experience the exhibition as a continuous field of encounters between artist, artwork, viewer and space.

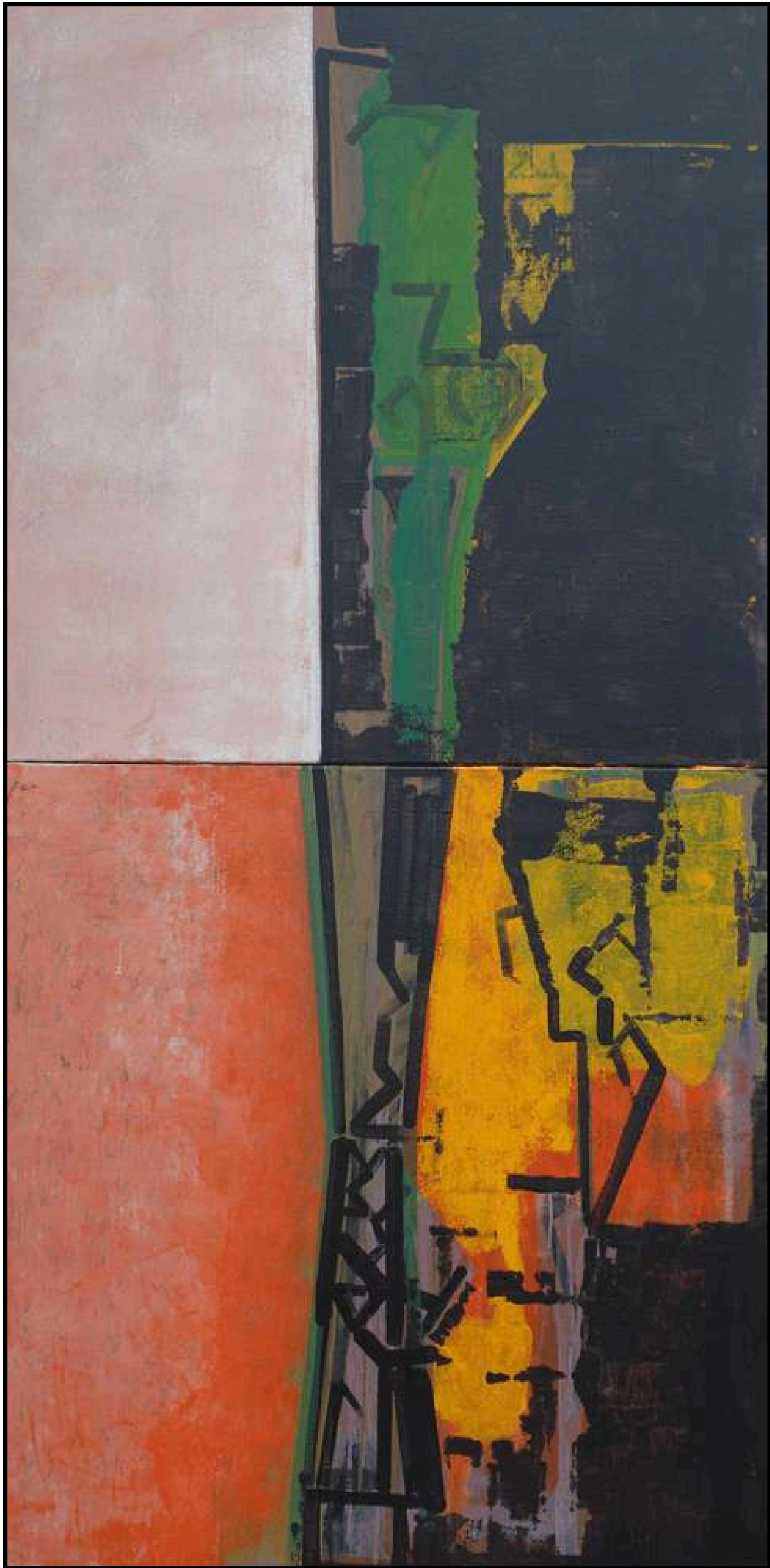

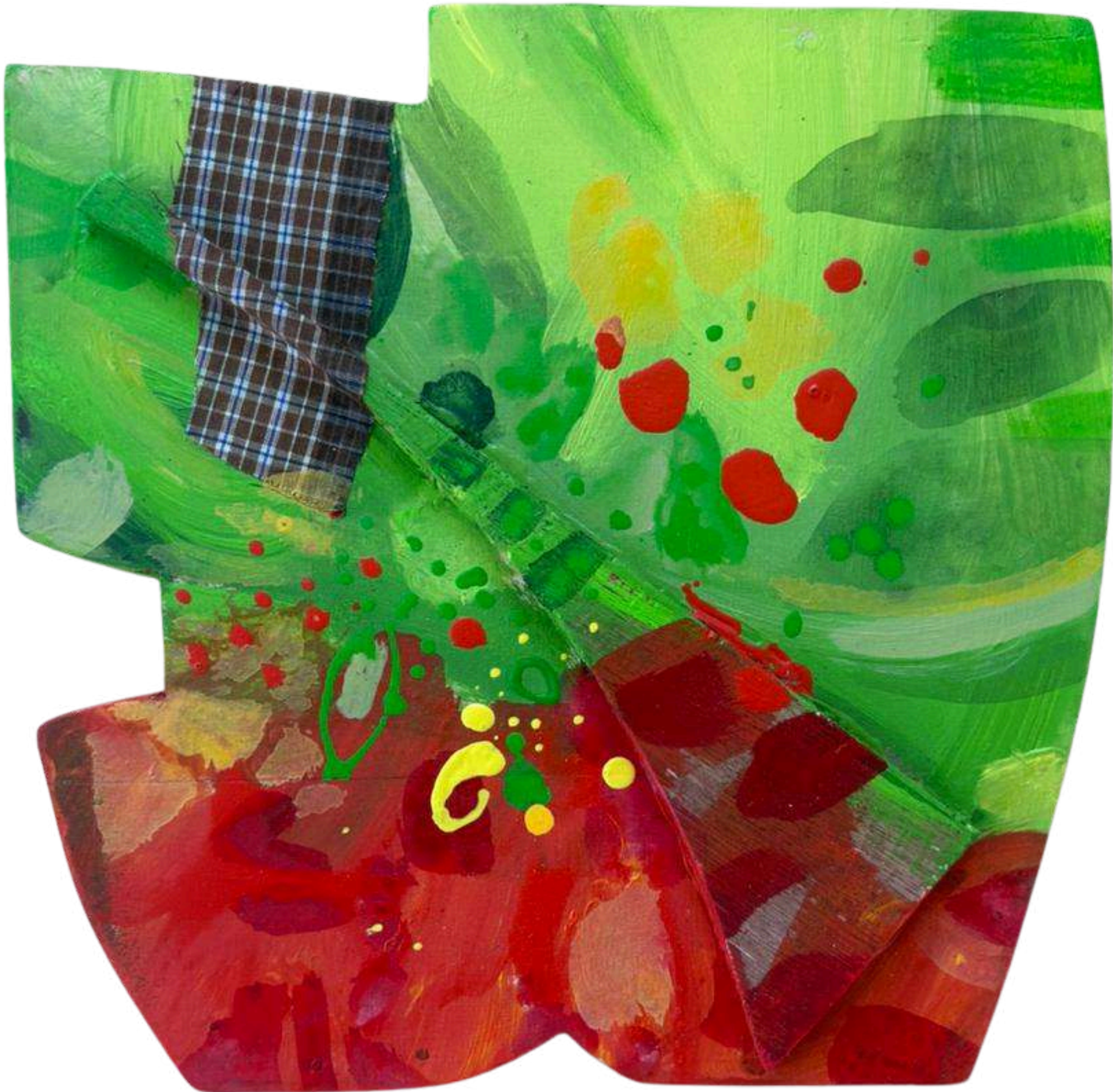

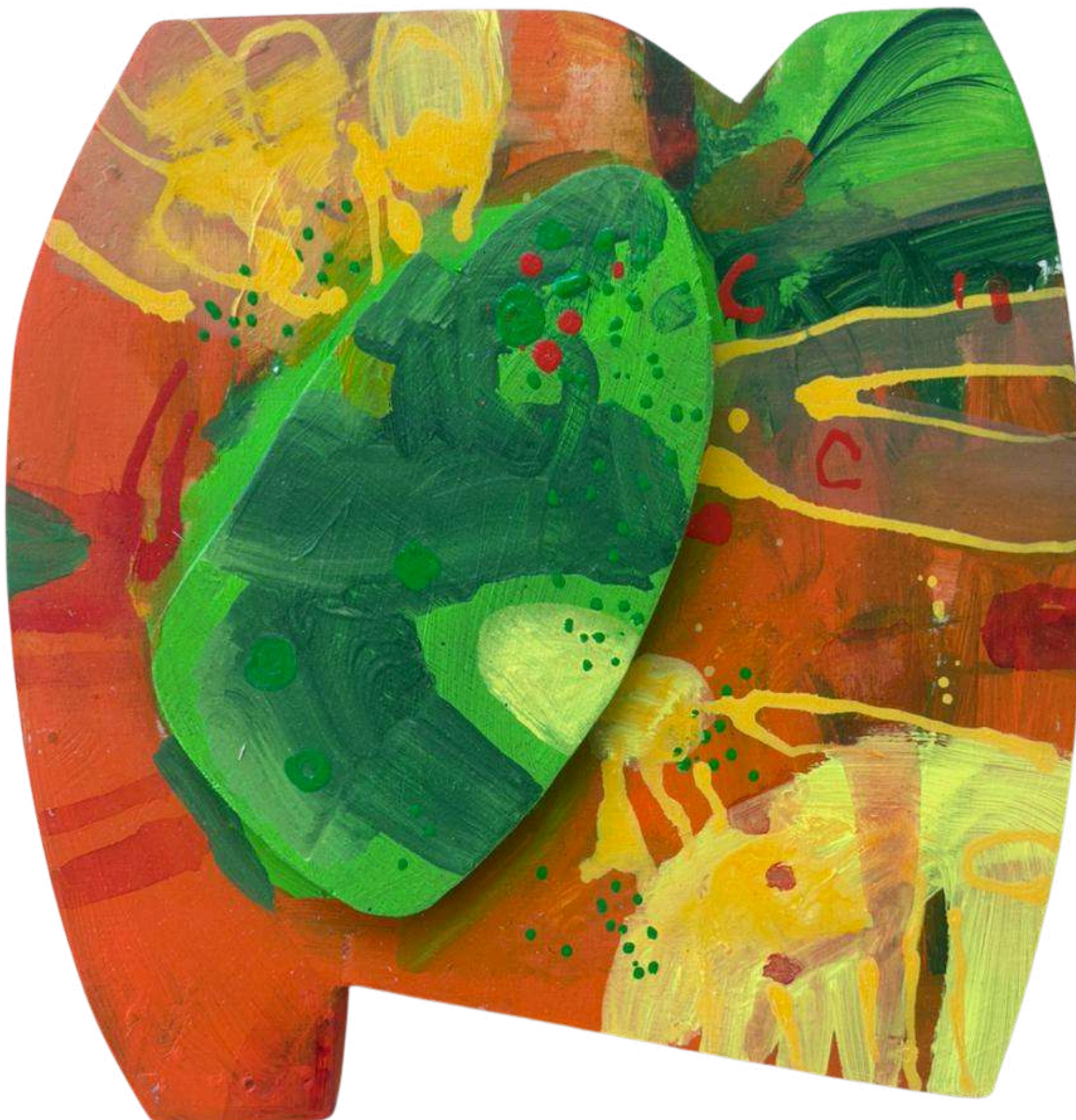

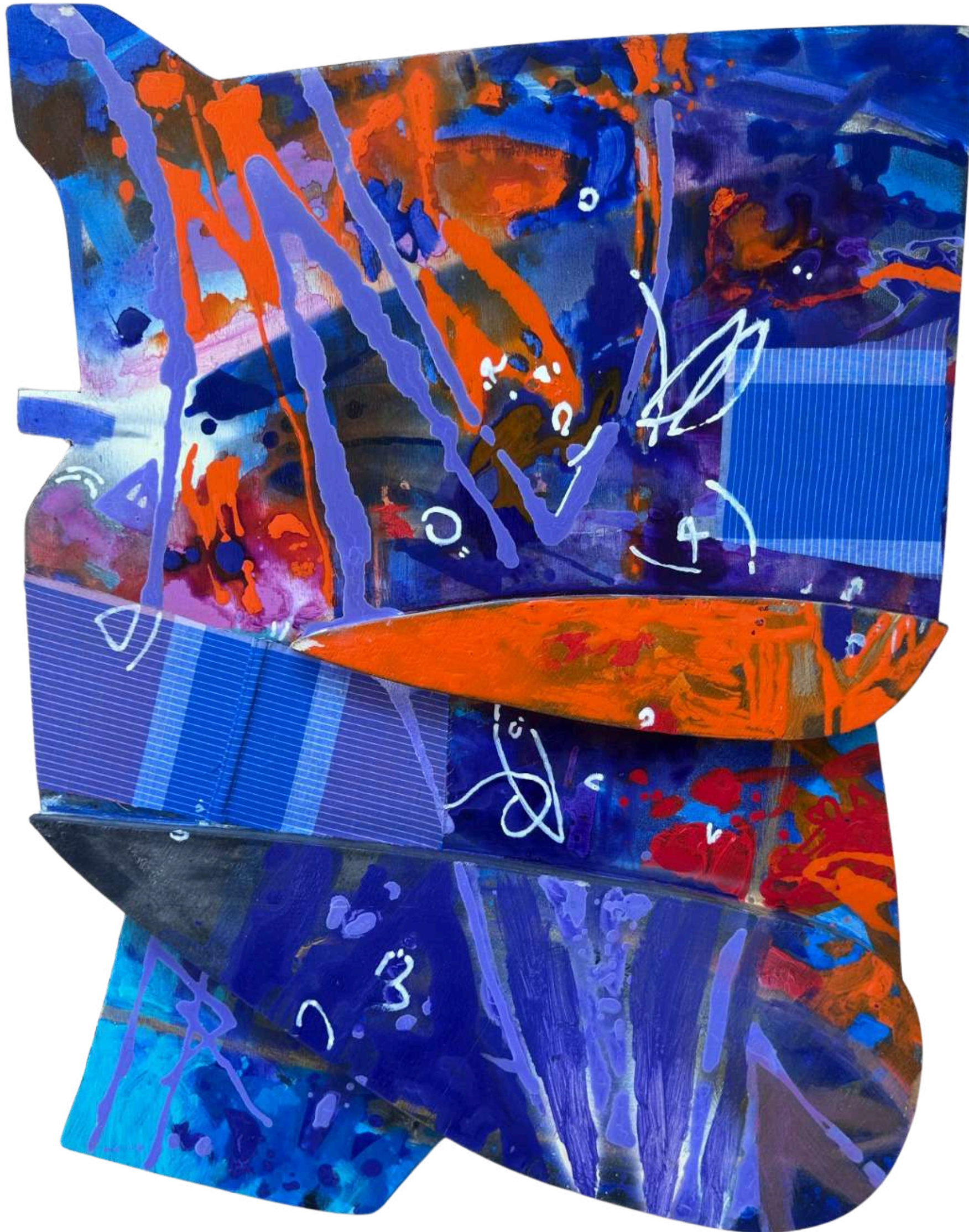

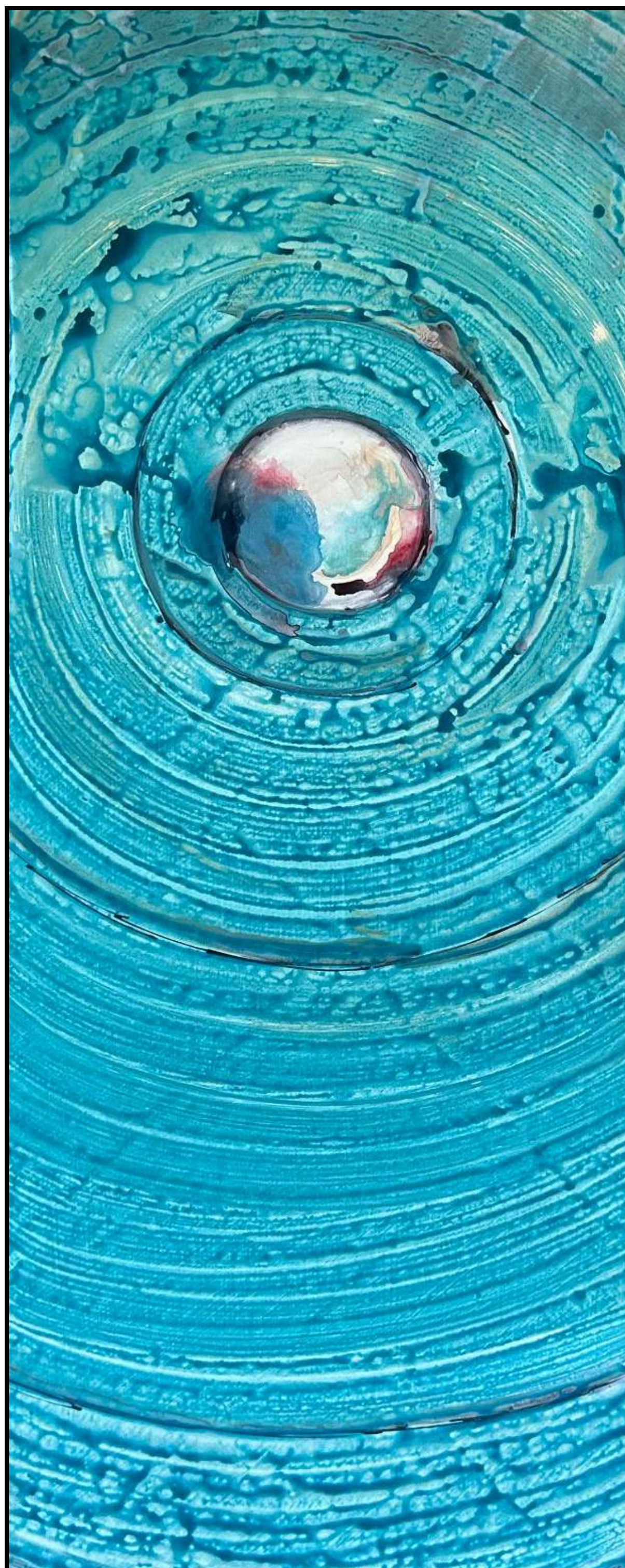

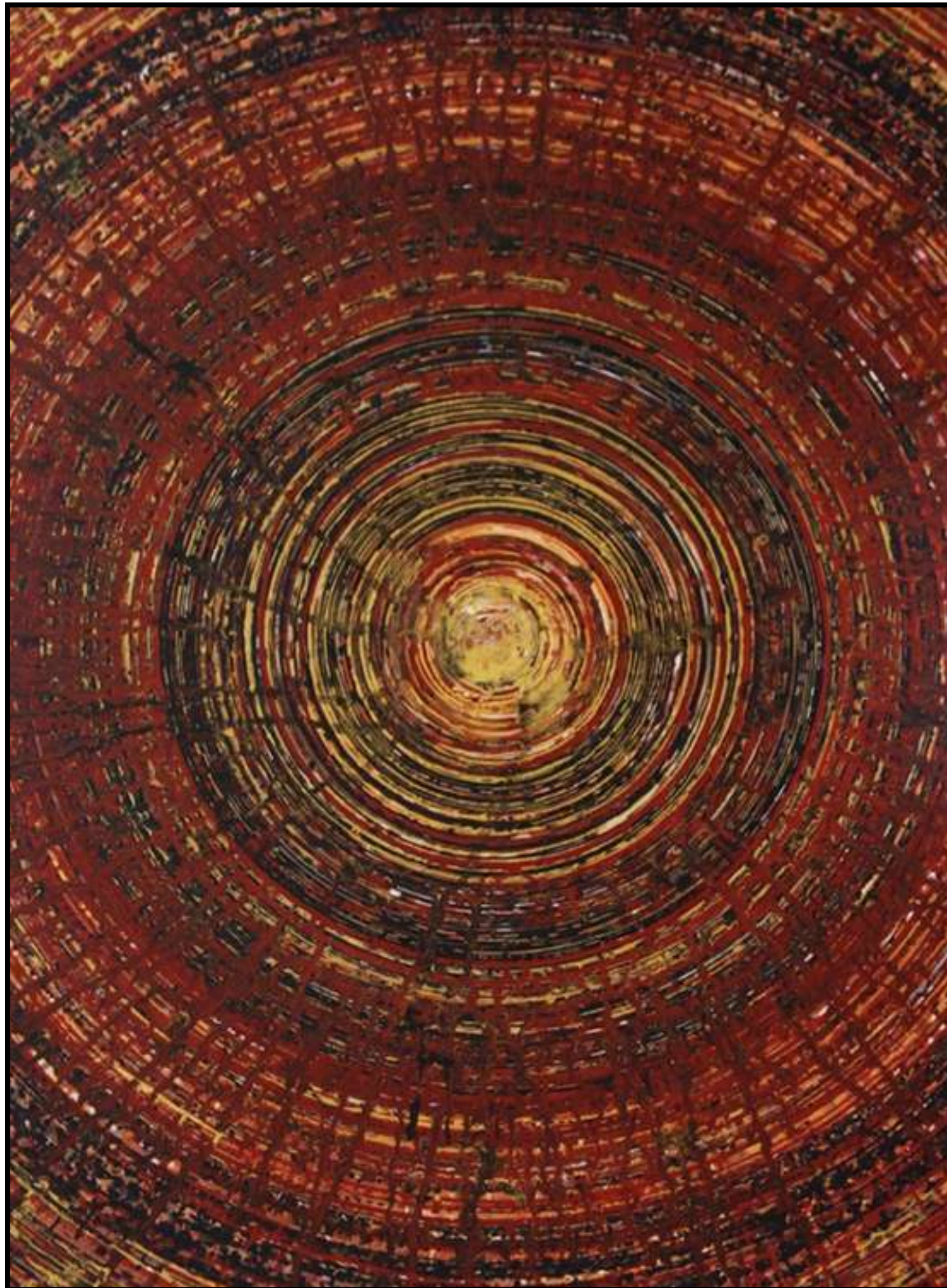

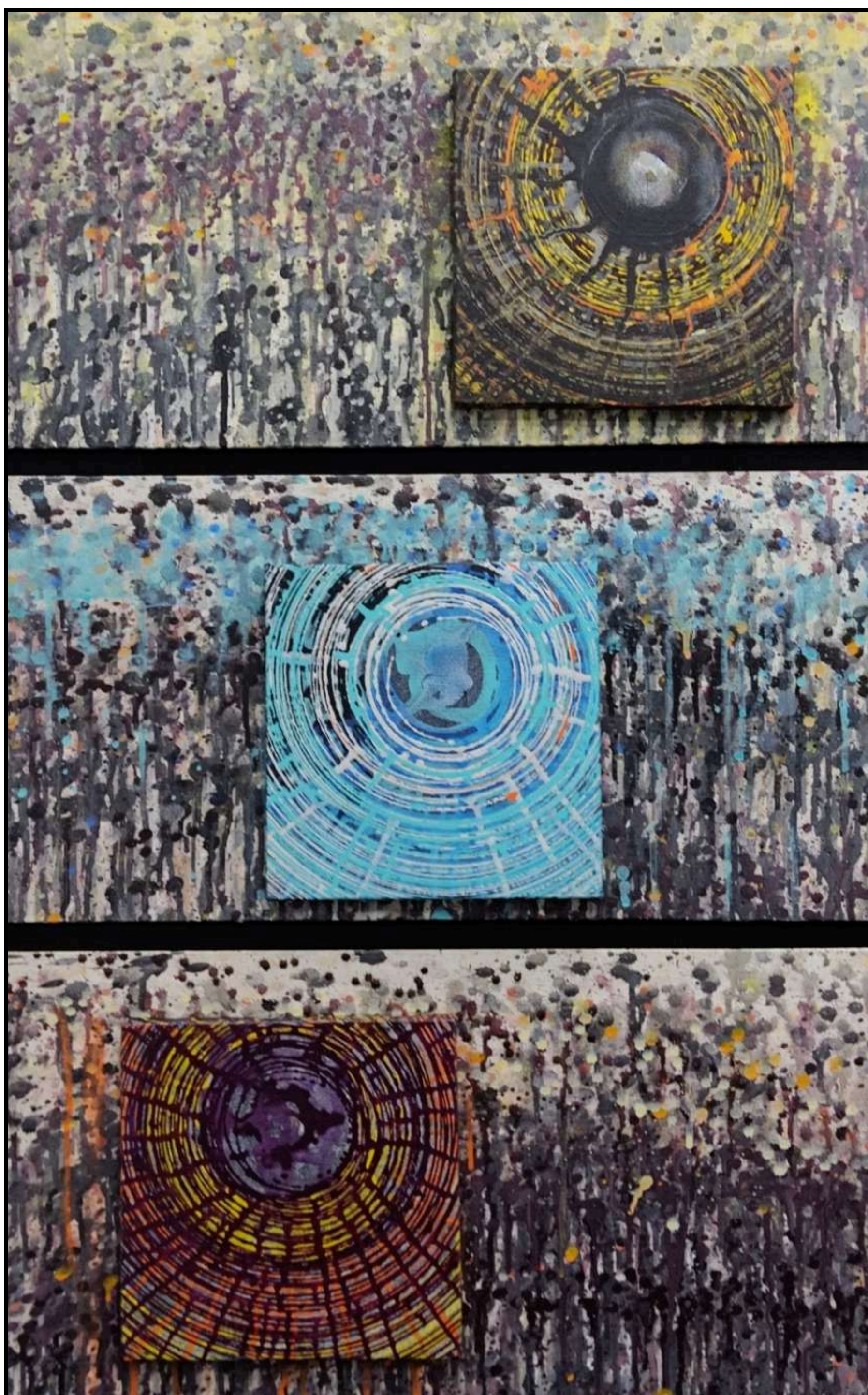

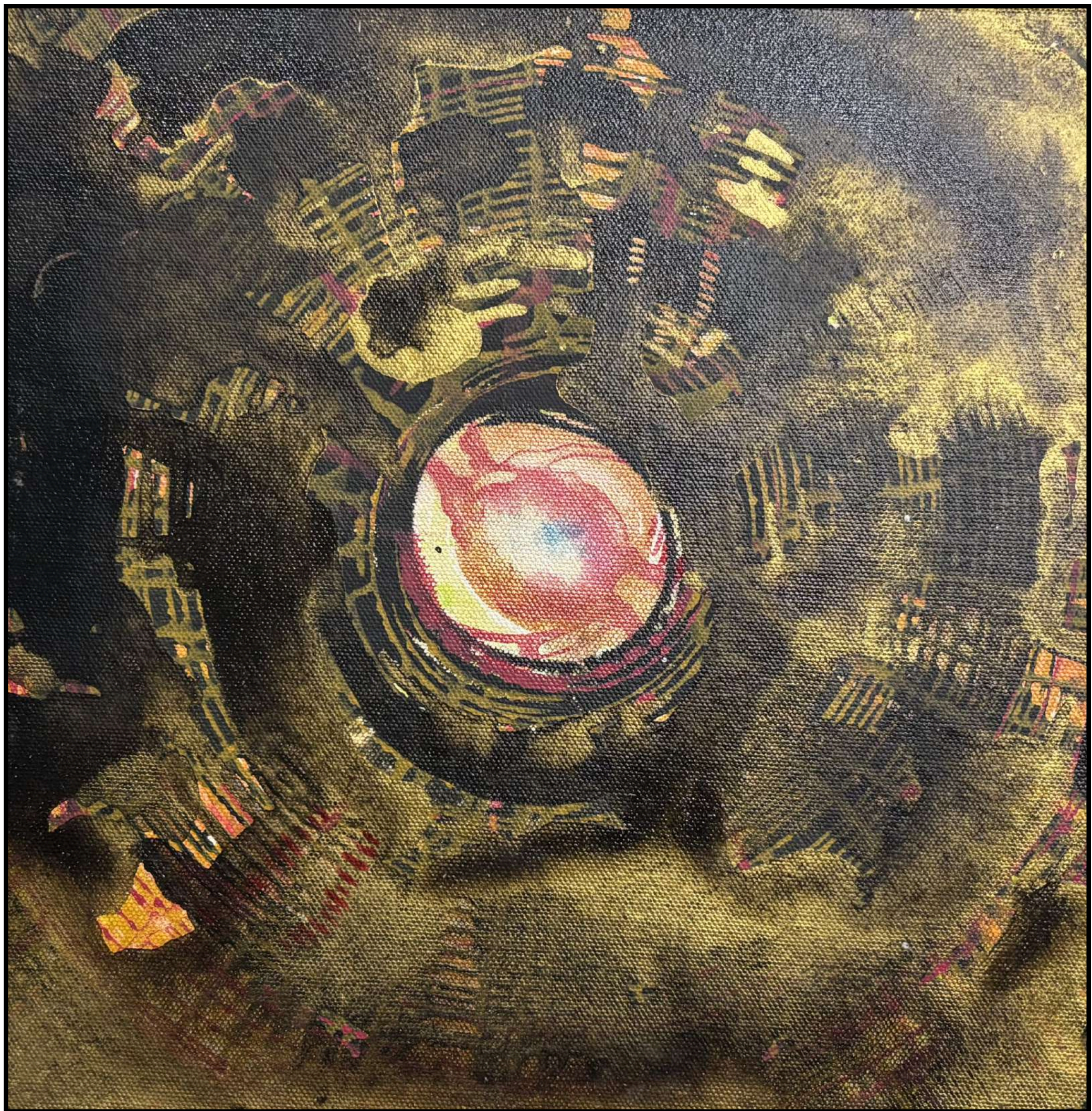

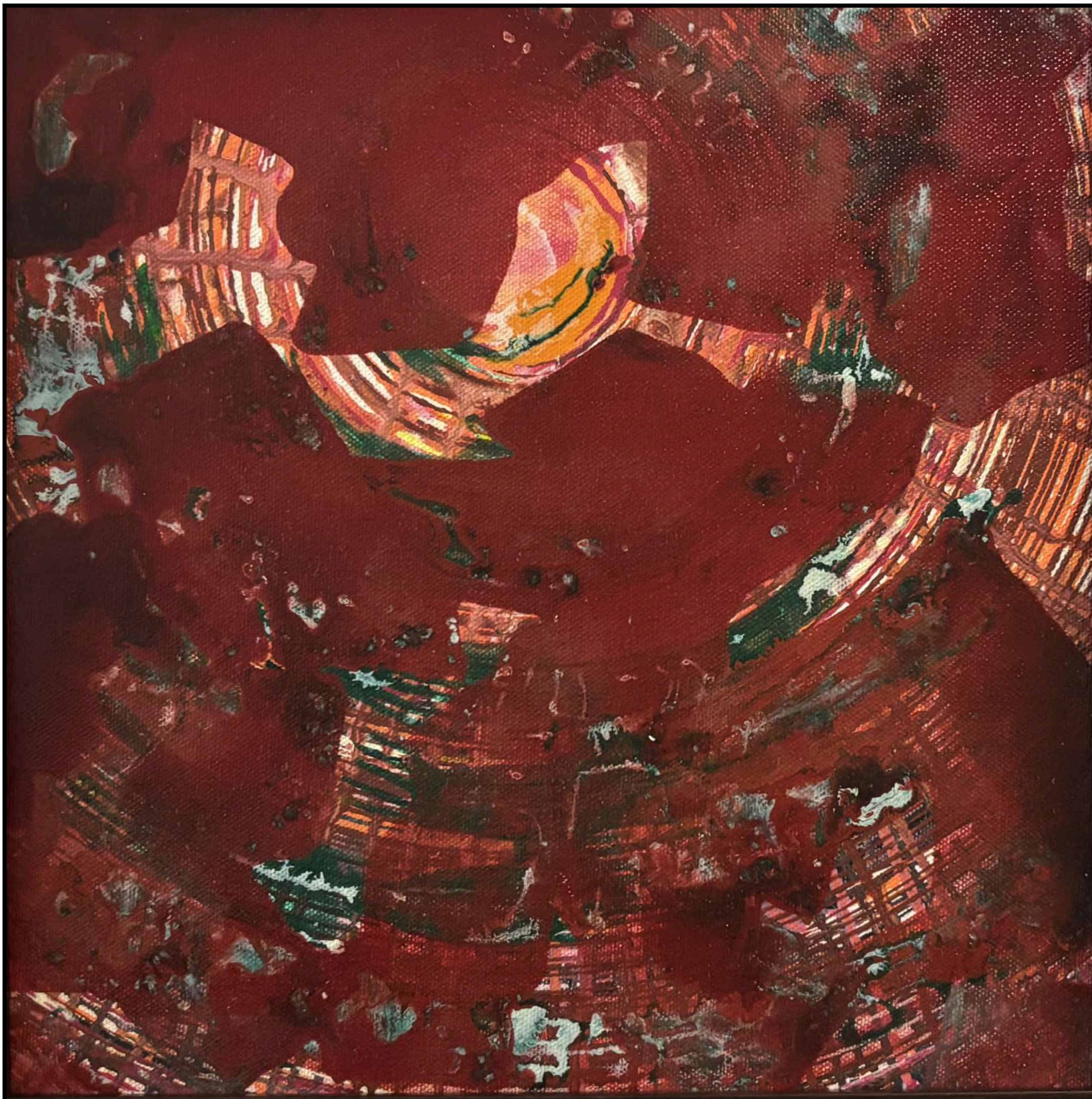

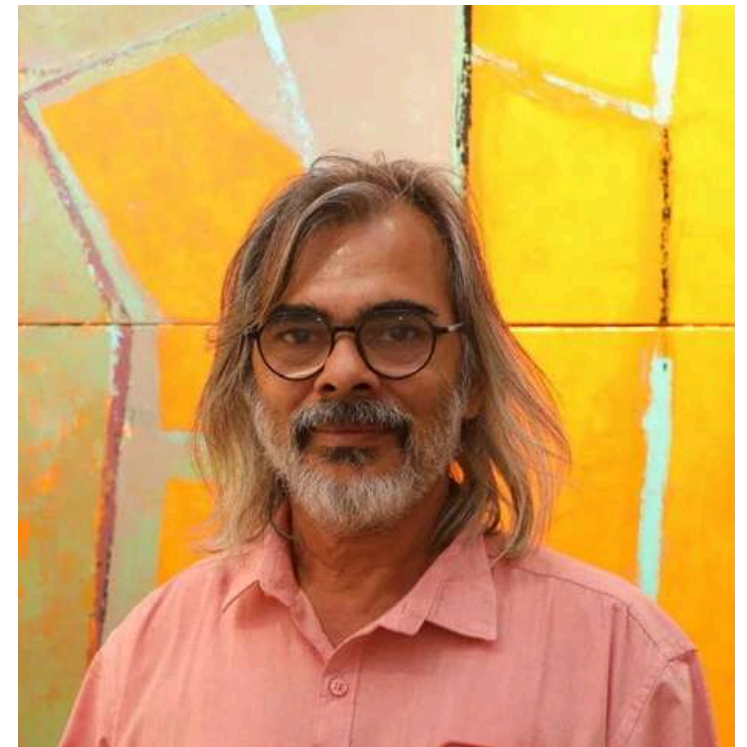

ARTIST'S PROFILE

BHAGWAN CHAVAN



Bhagwan Chavan is a Chennai-based abstract artist known for his expressive use of colour, rhythm and layered forms. A graduate of Sir J. J. School of Art(1983), Mumbai, his practice reflects influences from extensive travels and engagement with diverse artistic traditions. His paintings explore harmony through transparent and opaque tones, creating visual depth and movement. Chavan has exhibited widely in India and internationally, receiving prestigious honours including the 25th National Lalit Kala Akademi and recognition at the Bharat Bhavan Biennale in 1982.

DILIPKUMAR KESAVAN



Dilipkumar Kesavan, a Chennai-based artist, draws inspiration from his daily journey along the coastal road to his Mahabalipuram studio. Observing palms, shells, fabrics, lungis and everyday objects, he transforms these impressions into fluid, instinctive compositions. Rejecting rigid geometry, his works evolve organically through textures and unconventional materials that blur the boundaries between nature and human life. Rooted in lived experiences and subconscious expression, his art creates an unbound visual language of rhythm, memory, and connection.

JACOB JEBARAJ



Jacob Jebaraj's practice is rooted in sustainable art, exploring upcycling through paintings, sculptures, installations and serigraph techniques. Using layered textures, recycled materials and vernacular architectural references, his works merge tradition, innovation and environmental consciousness. His installations often address ecological themes such as water conservation and reuse. Alongside his artistic practice, he mentors differently abled children and develops collaborative, research-driven spaces for emerging artists, emphasizing both modern technology and traditional art techniques.

PRAVIN KANNANUR



Pravin Kannanur is a Chennai-based multidisciplinary artist working across visual arts, theatre, contemporary dance, installations and public art since 1989. His abstract paintings explore dynamic relationships between colour, texture, space and gesture inviting embodied engagement through memory and imagination. A founding member of Magic Lantern(the theatre group) and Basement 21 (The contemporary art collective), Pravin's collaborative practice spans local and international contexts. In 2022, he received the Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et Lettres from France.

CURATOR'S PROFILE

ISAIARASI ANNAMALAI



Isaiarasi Annamalai is an independent curator and artist based in Chennai whose practice explores the relationship between art, materiality and lived experience. Beginning with realistic painting during her initial years, she developed a strong foundation in colour, form and visual interpretation before gradually evolving towards abstraction and conceptual expression. Working primarily in oil and acrylic, Isai creates layered compositions that examine human emotions, memory, transformation and contemporary existence. Her works balance realism and symbolic abstraction, inviting viewers into reflective and meaningful visual experiences.

Alongside her artistic practice, Isai has established a curatorial approach centred on supporting artists and expanding engagement with contemporary visual culture. Through exhibitions and collaborative projects, she works closely with emerging and established artists to create immersive presentations that encourage dialogue between art and space.

As the Curatorial Director of The Collectors Room by Artiform, she brings together diverse artistic voices through thoughtfully curated exhibitions while continuing to actively develop and exhibit her own work within contemporary art platforms.
